THIS WEEK'S THEME: THE EMPTY GRAVE.

Day	Verses	Questions for Reflection
Mon	Psalms 30:3-5, 49:14-15	What does the word "grave" stand for in these Psalms? What kind of "graves" have you experienced and overcome in your journey with the Lord?
Tue	Luke 7:1-15, 8:40-56, John 11	What do these stories teach us about death? What was the concern of the chief priests and Pharisees? Do you have any insecurities that prevent you from experiencing and appreciating what God is doing around you? John 11:25-27: How does Martha respond to Jesus' comments about the resurrection?
Wed	John 5:28-29	How should we view the grave of believers?
Thu	Luke 24:1-44	When the women got to the tomb what did they find? Why does the angel call the disciples foolish according to verse 25? Compare also with verses 6-7, 44.
Fri	Luke 24:45-56:	What does Jesus highlight for the disciples? What is the responsibility of the disciples according to verse 48? What does that mean?
Sat	1 Corinthians 15:19-32	How should the empty grave change the way a believer looks at life and death?
Sun	2 Corinthians 4:14-18	What should the empty grave mean to the believers according to verse 14? What is our reality according to verse 16?
